A labor shortage is jeopardizing economic expansion in almost every state, putting pressure on lawmakers to find ways to attract more residents and coax people who have dropped out of the workforce to rejoin it. In 39 states, there are more jobs than people looking for them. Nationally the number of job openings in August was 7.1 million, compared with 6 million unemployed people looking for work. <u>More</u>.
